EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

ESN 1 - Lights are required on the race cars per the BCCR. Lights may be required to be on during inclement weather.

ESN 2 - Max sound of 96dba at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR.

ESN 3 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage. Track limits will be enforced.

ESN 4 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 5 - Flagtronics will be available for rent at \$50 per event weekend. Available at Race Central / Registration.

ESN 6 - Photo/Media Credentials: Cut-off for event credentials is 2-Weeks before event start. Please visit <https://champcar.org/web/media.php>

ESN 7 - Sahlen's Event Sponsor Decal is required and will be mounted on the door above your Class Letter. Get the decals at the Registration/Tech Garage.

ESN 8 - Passenger seat must be removed for the race.

Technical Information

ATTENTION: All vehicles, drivers, and crew must meet the safety and equipment requirements of the [2024 BCCR](#). Stint maximum of 2 hours per driver with a minimum of 1 hour between stints.

All fueling is to be completed on pitlane race day. Absolutely no fueling in the garages. Do not store fuel in the garages.

Driver & Crew Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form. The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration. Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics FT-200 serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display: Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar> Code35 will be in use at all ChampCar events. As ChampCar test the timing and scoring capabilities with the Flagtronics FT-200, it is imperative that your FT200 unit and the GPS is mounted within the rules and that the unit is working.

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft.

Alcohol: Absolutely no alcohol may be consumed in the during the day's racing events.

Venue Specific Information

NOTE: Testing, tuning, brake bedding, high speed accelerations or braking will be limited to the track, and not allowed in the paddock or surrounding public roadways. Doing so could result in event expulsion with no fees returned.

2024 Tech Inspection: The Tech line will open on Friday at 11:00 PM and will remain open until 6:00 PM. Please complete your Web-based tech form and the car ready for safety inspection by ChampCar tech staff. Please have your Number / Sponsor panels installed. All teams will be given new 2024 sponsor panels. They must be installed at Tech.

Minors: No individual under the age of eighteen (18) years of age shall be allowed. Participants must be eighteen (18) years of age or older.

Arrival Procedures: Friday - Teams will be required to first park in Lot 3 and walk into the registration building by gate 4A. Registration building will be open from 7:00am - 6:00pm on Friday.

Do not pull trailers into the registration parking lot. In the registration office teams will sign the waiver and get a wristband that lets them enter the facility. With their wristband on, they will drive their truck and trailer back down CR16 and enter at Gate 2. Security at gate 2 will verify they have their wristband and let them enter the paddock. Late arrivals on Friday will need to camp in Lot 3. You will be able to sign and get a ChampCar issued wrist band at 7:00am on Saturday. WGI will not allow anyone in without a ChampCar issued wristband. Driver / Crew bands will NOT work.

NO EXCEPTIONS.

Test & Tune: ChampCar is hosting the Test-Practice session on Friday. Cost is \$200 per car. Pay at Registration. Required drivers meeting at noon. Remember that you must get your car through Tech and Registration during the day, make time for it during your testing sessions.

Track Access: No one is allowed access to the track after operations hours for any reason, i.e., running, walking, etc.

Paddock Electric: Limited power in the paddocks. See map. You must pay WGI Security personel, they will then unlock the power pole. \$50 fee to WGI security staff. These are located around the outside edge of the paddock.

Pitlane Access: The pitlane area gate is locked at the conclusion of the days events. Please plan accordingly.

Pitlane Electric: Electrical hookups are limited along pitlane.

Pitlane Speed: 20 mph at all times.

Media Information

Radio Frequencies: The ChampCar radio frequencies are reserved for ChampCar official use only and must not be used by the track or teams during the event. Monitor the [Race Logs](#)

Lighting: Some lighting is available but teams should bring additional lighting.

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members. Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you paddock and cold pit lane access. See rules for minors.

Pets: Pets allowed into the track must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Pet access is a privilege not a right. The track reserves the right to deny pet access to the property at any time.

Children: No children 18 or under on pit road. Remember, this is New York. They have some very strict rules about age restrictions for minors, these are state laws, not just track rules.

Camping / RV Hookups: Self-contained RV camping is allowed Friday & Saturday night in your paddock. If you want one of the 25 RV sites with hookups you must book it separately. \$50 Hookup fee to WGI Security.

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Restroom / Showers: Yes / Yes - Located Near Camping Area on Richardson Road.

Gate: 4-hour gate coverage. Must have ChampCar WGI Wristband. No admission without it.

Concessions: Will be open for this event.

Fuel on site: There are local gas stations in town. They may close early in town, so plan accordingly. Used oil and petroleum waste dump is located in the garage paddock. WGI Fuel Station Hours are: 8:00 AM – 11:30 AM and 12:00 PM – 3:30 PM.

Drones: Unmanned aircraft systems and drones are prohibited at ChampCar Endurance events at all times.

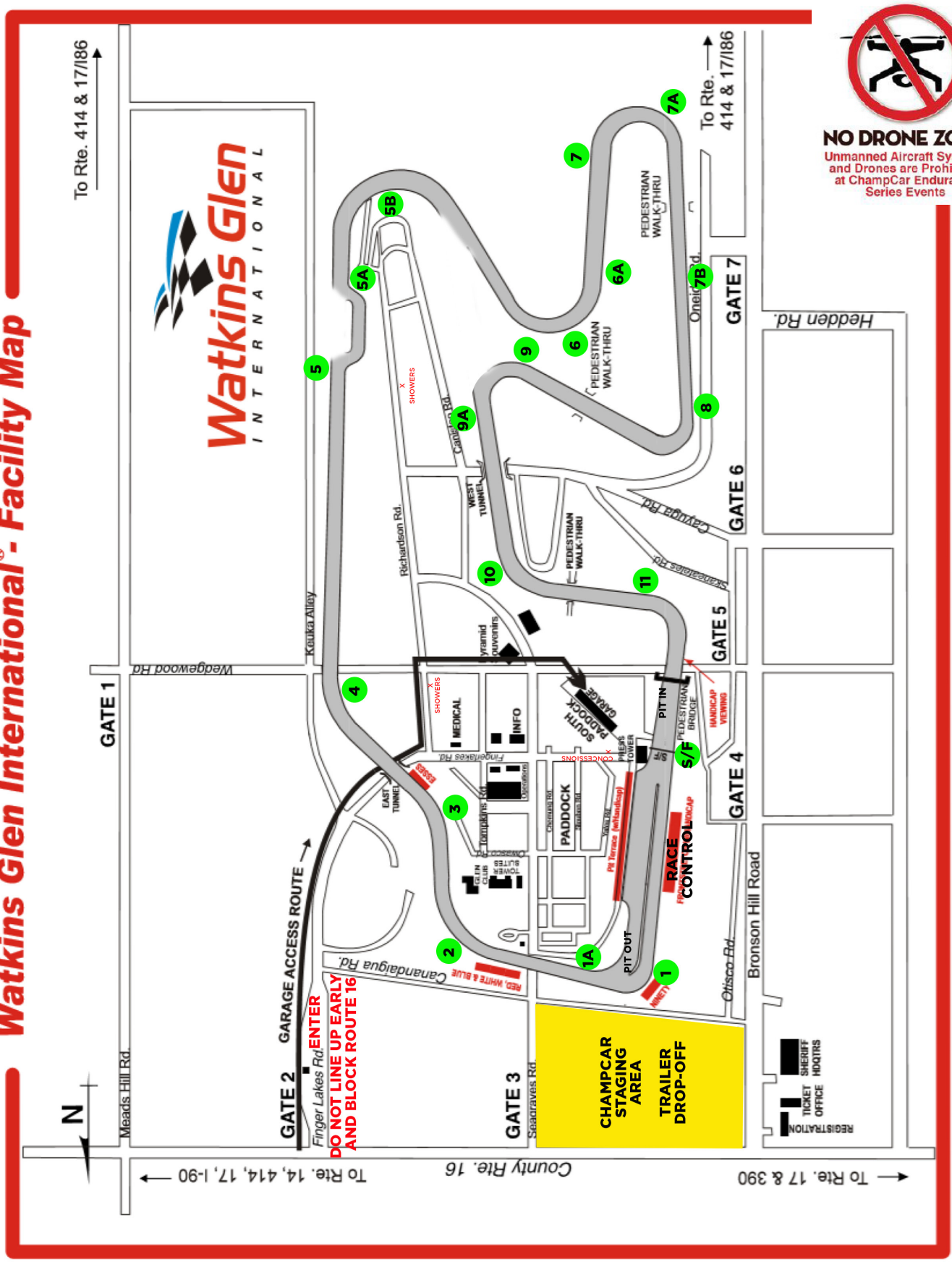

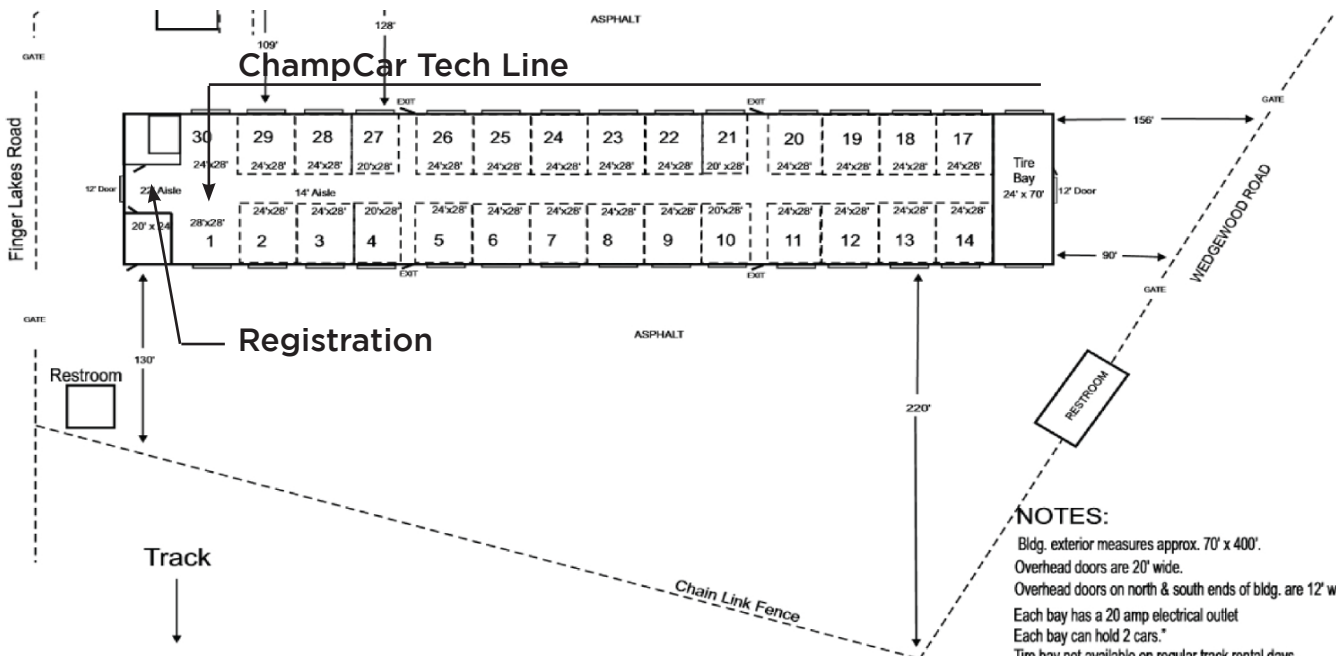
