Super Important Information:

Early staging will be in LOT G.

The move from Lot G to the paddock is dependent on the school using the track Friday. When they are done we can move in. Tech and Registration will also have to move, so please be patient. We will try to keep Tech and Registration open late enough to accommodate everyone.

Gate: Barber entry wristbands allow 24-hour access through the Barber main gate.

Friday registration opens at 1pm in LOT G, and will remain open until 6pm. Everyone will hand in their waivers and get a Barber entry wristband from registration. This will allow you to enter the facility when it opens around 6pm Friday. If you arrive after 6pm, you must visit the Credentials Building next to the main gate to turn in your waivers, and get your Barber entry wristband. If you arrive after 11pm Friday, you will not be able to enter the facility, and can stay in Lot G, until credential building opens up at 6am on Saturday. The Credential Building will be open from 6am-4pm on Saturday and 6am to 3pm on Sunday. You will not be allowed into the Barber Facility unless you have the entry wrist band.

Garages: Not available

**Paddock & Pitlane Electric: Electrical hookups are available. Use of power at Barber requires the purchase of a \$50 tag. The tag can be purchased from a Barber staff member at Registration.

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Pit Passes: Teams are advised that all team members, family, and guests who desire Pit Lane access MUST purchase a Weekend Membership Pass (\$20) through ChampCar at the track. ChampCar members can obtain a free pit pass by showing their membership card. All over the wall team members MUST be full members (\$50).

Guest Pass: Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the gate and watch the race for \$20. Children 17 and under free.

Pets: Barber Motorsports Park does not allow pets.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road.

Camping / Camper: Teams may camp overnight in their paddock spaces. Campers in the paddock require the same \$25 tag for electrical connections.

Barbecues: Gas BBQ's are allowed in the paddock area only. No charcoal cooking. A fire extinguisher is required within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Bathrooms and showers are available in the paddock area.

Concessions: Bruno Hospitality will be offering food and beverage from 10AM to 2PM Saturday and Sunday in the Paddock. This change is in response to challenges presented by Covid-19. We hope to return back to normal hours in January 2021. If your group needs catering services beyond concessions, please contact us at 205-699-2783.

Racing Parts & Gear Supplies: DiscoveryParts, a ChampCar Sponsor, will be bringing their "Mobile Technology Center" (aka big support trailer) to the ChampCar Barber December 12/13 race. If there is anything special you would like us to bring, please let us know before Wednesday December 9 noon EST as the trailer leaves early Thursday. We already have a very full will-call box and thank you for the support of our company.

Fuel on site: 93 and 98 octane fuel is available at self serve pumps on site.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

Sunday RED FLAG Quiet Hour Procedures:

At 10:45am pit lane will be closed. The race will be red-flagged at 11:00am. All cars will be brought down pit lane. All work must stop on cars in the pit and paddock.

Drivers will exit cars, and you may remove in-car data cards/cameras. No work will be allowed on the cars.

Drivers will be called back to the cars at 11:45 am. You may only re-insert data cards and cameras, and add ice to your cool suit boxes when the race restarts. Driver stints reset. Race cars can be restarted at Noon.

The pace car will lead the field out of pit lane, and come in after one lap. You must do one lap before you can pit, unless car is broke on pit lane, then you can start your pit stop after the cars on track have taken the green flag.

Flagging: Barber will now require a full course double yellow for all track recoveries. Flaggers will be using the "code 35" flag. A pace car is not required. We ask that all drivers drop down to 35 mph, and maintain the distance between you and the car in front while we recover or clean up any incident with the exception of an oil spill that requires more time.
