EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

ESN 1 - Teams may add up to 10% antifreeze to their radiators for this event.

ESN 2 - Headlights are required on the race cars per the BCCR. All lights must be installed and operating by 6:00pm. Lights may be required during inclement weather.

ESN 3 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR.

ESN 4 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 5 - Event Sponsor Decal installation instructions - None

ESN 6 - ChampCar is utilizing the Club Paddock and pits.

ESN 7 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 8 - Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display will be available, but is not required until June 1, 2022.

Technical Information

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams at Road Atlanta will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Speedwaiver: New for 2022. More info soon.

Racing Gear Self Inspection: Gear inspection, use, and maintenance is each members personal responsibility. Members are required to annually inspect all personal safety gear and confirm it meets ChampCar minimum requirements. By accepting a member's annual gear check, neither ChampCar, nor its directors, officers, sponsors, staff, and/or officials, ensure, certify, or warrant that the gear fully complies with all ChampCar rules, or will prevent bodily injury, death, or other harm (including, monetary damages). ChampCar expressly disclaims all consequential damages, regardless the cause.

Drivers will not be allowed on track without the proper gear per the BCCR. Spot checks on pit lane may be conducted along with pit out.

ChampCar Officials will be available at tech inspection to assist members with gear inspection.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:
This information is subject to change.

Required June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. The system will be working at this event. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent.

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Lights: Have all lights installed and working for tech inspection.

Venue Specific Information

Test & Tune Information: Friday, free to all registered teams. See schedule for session times. Only event registered cars and teams may participate. Passengers allowed with the same safety gear as the driver.

Paddock: ChampCar will be using the Club Paddock.

Paddock Electric: Very limited, and it has not always worked in the past. Bring generators if power is needed. The paddock gets VERY dark.

Pitlane Electric: None. Bring generators.

Pit Lane Heaters: Heaters on pit lane are not allowed.

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/ paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Venue Specific Information

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members. Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you spectator and cold pit lane access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

Pets: They are welcome on property, but must be kept on a leash. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets and must dispose of their waste properly. Pets are not allowed in the cold pits.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road.

Camping: Self-contained RV camping is allowed Thursday, Friday & Saturday night. Must be out by 11am Sunday.

Camping / Camper Hookups: There are no hookups, and only one or two power pole hookups. These get taken fast so bring a generator.

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. / Yes. Located across from the Race Control Tower.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: Open Saturday. The Paddock Grille is located at the top of the outer paddock.

Fuel on site: Credit card pumps available in the Club Paddock. The VP Racing Fuels gas station dispenses 93 unleaded, C9 (96 unleaded), and 110 leaded during both public and private track rentals. The fuel station is also dispensing C10 non-ethanol 100 octane fuel.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

Photo/Media Credentials: There will be a limit as to how many credentials are issued. Cut-off for event credentials is 2-Weeks before event start. Please visit



