EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

ESN 1 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR. **Mufflers are required at CMP.**

ESN 2 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 3 - Event Sponsor Decal installation instructions - None

ESN 4 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 5 - Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display will be available to rent. Limited quantities available. See page 2.

ESN 6 - Sunday Quiet Time: in observance of local church services, the track shall observe quiet time on Sunday from 11am to 12pm. Absolutely NO race engines may be run during this time.

ESN 7 - All ChampCar decals must be installed prior to tech inspection. No exception.

Technical Information

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Speedwaiver: New for 2022. More info soon.

Racing Gear Self Inspection: Gear inspection, use, and maintenance is each member's personal responsibility. Members are required to annually inspect all personal safety gear and confirm it meets ChampCar minimum requirements. By accepting a member's annual gear check, neither ChampCar, nor its directors, officers, sponsors, staff, and/or officials, ensure, certify, or warrant that the gear fully complies with all ChampCar rules, or will prevent bodily injury, death, or other harm (including, monetary damages). ChampCar expressly disclaims all consequential damages, regardless the cause. Drivers will not be allowed on track without the proper gear per the BCCR. Spot checks on pit lane may be conducted along with pit out. ChampCar Officials will be available at tech inspection to assist members with gear inspection.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:
This information is subject to change.

Required starting June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent.

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Lights: Lights for this event are not required, but should be available in case of inclement weather racing.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft. Sound measuring is driver's left.

Venue Specific Information

Quiet Times: No race engines may run before 7:30am or after 8pm. No loud music is permitted after 10 pm. Be considerate of neighbors. Camping quiet time begins at 10 pm. Sunday Quiet Time: in observance of local church services, the track shall observe quiet time on Sunday from 11am to 12pm. Absolutely NO race engines may be run during this time.

Test and Tune Information: TBD

Paddock & Paddock Speed Limit: 10 MPH

No parking, repairing, or refueling vehicles or placing scales or jack stands on any paddock road. These access roads are considered an Emergency Fire Lane by the Fire Marshall. All tires, broken fiberglass, scrap metal, batteries, and any other parts which have been removed or fallen off cars must be removed from Carolina Motorsports Park.

Pit Lane Speed Limit: 20 MPH

Garages: Garages are reserved through CMP website. Do not store gasoline inside of the garages.

Waiver and Wristbands: Only the team captain needs to check in at registration to receive driver and crew credentials. More information will be available as we get closer to the event.

Pitlane Electric: None. Bring a generator.

Lighting: The paddock has minimal area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Motorized Vehicles: No pit bikes, dirt bikes or minibikes are allowed on the premises without prior approval from the track manager.

Facility and Facility Lake: No fishing or swimming in the lake. The lake is off limits to ALL activities.

No climbing or jumping ANY fences.

Do not damage any grassy area in any manner.

Environmental: All trash must be placed in the receptacles provided. Environmentally hazardous waste MUST be disposed of in appropriate receptacles.

Any spill MUST be reported to CMP staff for immediate clean up.

Please dump waste oil into yellow 55-gallon drums marked "OIL". Please dump anti-freeze into blue 55-gallon drums marked "ANTI-FREEZE".

Do not dump race fuel into recycling drums. You shall be billed the disposal fee for contaminated liquids. Fuel cannot be sold at the track or pre-sold for delivery to the track.

Do not pour gasoline, oil, antifreeze, or other fluids on the ground.

You shall be billed for any items left at the track that must be disposed of by a disposal company (i.e. tires, batteries, fuel barrels, etc.).

Venue Specific Information

Weekend Memberships: Weekend memberships can be purchased for \$20 at ChampCar Race Central.

Pets: All pet animals must be leashed or confined. Owners are responsible for their behavior, damages, and clean-ups. Pets are not allowed in any of the buildings, concession area, false grid, or pit area at any time.

Children: Minor waivers for track entrance. No one under 16 allowed to operate golf carts, pit wagons, or any powered vehicle.

Camping / Camper Hookups: Camping spaces with 30amp power are pre-reserved through the CMP website. Camping quiet time begins at 10 pm. No loud music is permitted. Be considerate of neighbors. Campfires are only allowed in fire pits which contain and lift the fire off the ground. 20amp power is available in some additional spaces, all 20amp and non-powered camping spaces are first-come first-choice.

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. / Yes.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Sunday 7am-2pm Breakfast-Lunch

Fuel on site: Available for sale in 5-gallon containers, 98/100/110. There is also a mini-mart that sells pump gas out side of the facility gate.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

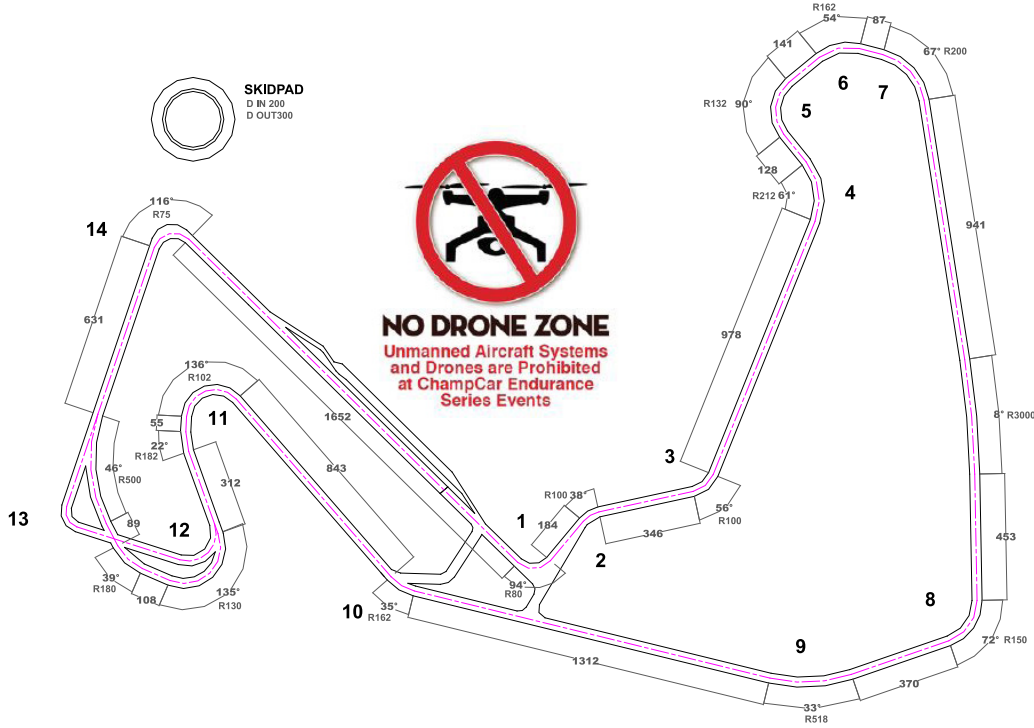
