#### **Technical Information**

**Race Car Tech Inspection:** All teams will be required to do the Online Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

#### Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:

Flagtronics is required from June 1, 2022, onwards.

Flagtronics Downloads: The Flagtronics Device Manager software is an easy-to-use software interface to prep your FT-200 with the latest software and track maps. Just open up the software and plug the FT-200 USB into your computer, follow the direction for upgrades, or install track maps.

**Fire Bottle Inspection:** Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

#### **Event & Venue Information**

**Pets:** They are welcome in the paddock only, but must be kept on a leash.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road.

**Camping / Camper Hookups:** Yes. Self-contained RV camping is allowed Friday & Saturday night. No hookups.

**Barbecues:** BBQ's are allowed in the paddock area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: Open Saturday and Sunday.

**Restroom / Showers:** Restrooms and showers are available in the paddock garage next to DiscoveryParts.

Fuel on site: None.

**Fluid Disposal:** Fluid wastes must be placed in approved disposal containers located at various sites in the paddocks and NEVER on the ground.

**Weather:** We're racing, regardless of the weather. Prepare for rain, heat, and high humidity.

**Hotels:** Please call hotels in the area early as there are usually other events going on in the area, so hotels may be hard to get.
