Technical Information

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams at Road Atlanta will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Speedwaiver: TBD.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:
This information is subject to change.

Required June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. The system will be working at this event. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent.

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Lights: Have all lights installed and working for tech inspection. Race Event - All lights must be installed and operating by 6:00pm. Lights may be required during inclement weather.

Venue Specific Information

Test & Tune Information: Friday practice will be from 9:00am till noon (1 hour lunch break), 1:00pm till 5pm, and night test 8:00pm till 10:00pm. Cost is \$300 per team (unlimited drivers). Payment will be at the gate. A two-hour session in both am and pm, for fuel calculation and light aiming. Arrival on Thursday evening is recommended.

Paddock Electric: The paddock is all grass. Bring plywood to put under your car, jack, and jackstands. During rain conditions the paddock can turn into a mud bowl. Be prepared with easyups and ground cover. The cold side of pit lane is also a good place to use plywood on the ground to keep your shoes dry and less muddy.

Warning: When choosing your paddock location, chose higher elevation areas as water collects in the low areas. Pay attention to the weather.

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/ paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures. VERY limited. Bring your own pit and paddock lighting and generators.

Weekend Membership Passes: Cannot go over the wall, \$20 for the weekend at registration. Over the wall crew must be full ChampCar club members.

Venue Specific Information

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members. Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you spectator and cold pit lane access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

Pets: They are welcome on property, but must be kept on a leash. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets and must dispose of their waste properly. Pets are not allowed in the cold pits.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road.

Camping: RV and trailer camping in the paddock is allowed on thursday - Monday, noon. Overnight Camping. Self-contained RV camping is allowed Friday thru Sunday. There are no hook-up sites. Space in the paddock is limited, teams may camp in the paddock, however teams with both a hauler and a separate camper are advised to park their camper in the over-flow area.

Camping / Camper Hookups: No hookups in paddock. No water or sewer hookups are provided. No RV dumping is available.

Barbecues: Subject to change due to fire season. No open campfires or barrel fires are allowed. Only contained, manufactured barbeques and grills are permitted. BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. / Yes.

Gate: 24-hour gate. The front gate will be open overnight during the event. During the race, you must use the bridge.

Concessions: Yes. Pitstop Grill. Hours TBD.

Fuel on site: Yes. Pay cash or credit at the track pumps. Fuel. 93 octane pump-gas is available on site. The tank capacity at the track is around 5,000. You guys see where I'm going with this right? Bring some fuel with you. But, the track is looking into having an additional fuel truck onsite for the race.

Keep your fuel jugs, drums, and containers covered if it rains. Water in your fuel will ruin your weekend.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

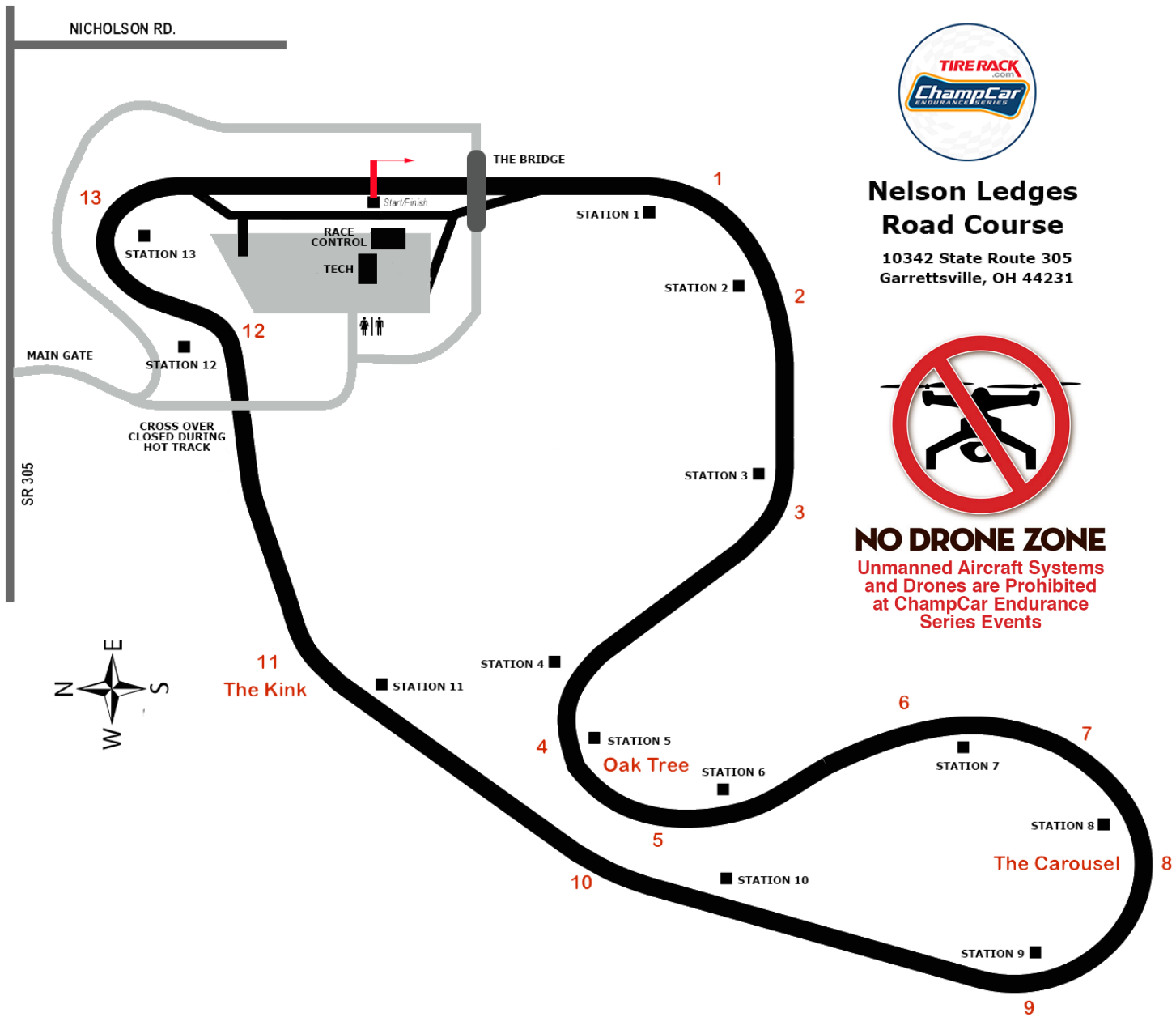
