Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Sound: Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR.

Venue Specific Information

Directions: NOLA Motorsports Park is located in Avondale, New Orleans, in the state of Louisiana, USA. The nearest airport is Louis Armstrong New Orleans International, located around 30 minutes drive to the north.

The circuit can be found on Nicole Boulevard, around 30 minutes drive from the city's French Quarter. From the city centre, head out on US-90 (West Bank Expressway) and then exit onto Segnette Boulevard (signposted for TPC Louisiana Golf Course). Follow the road as it continues into Nicole Boulevard - the circuit entrance is on the left after around 1.5 miles.

Paddock & Pit lane Electric: There are limited paddock electric spots. See map page 4. There is no electric in the center of the paddock. Bring generators.

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/ paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Pets: Pets allowed into the track must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Pet access is a privilege not a right. The track reserves the right to deny pet access to the property at any time.

?? Children: No children under-16 allowed on pit road.

Camping / Camper Hookups: Self-contained RV camping is allowed Friday & Saturday night. Must be out of the paddock by Sunday night. 44 RV Hookups with Power & Water. Contact the track to reserve. (504) 302-4875

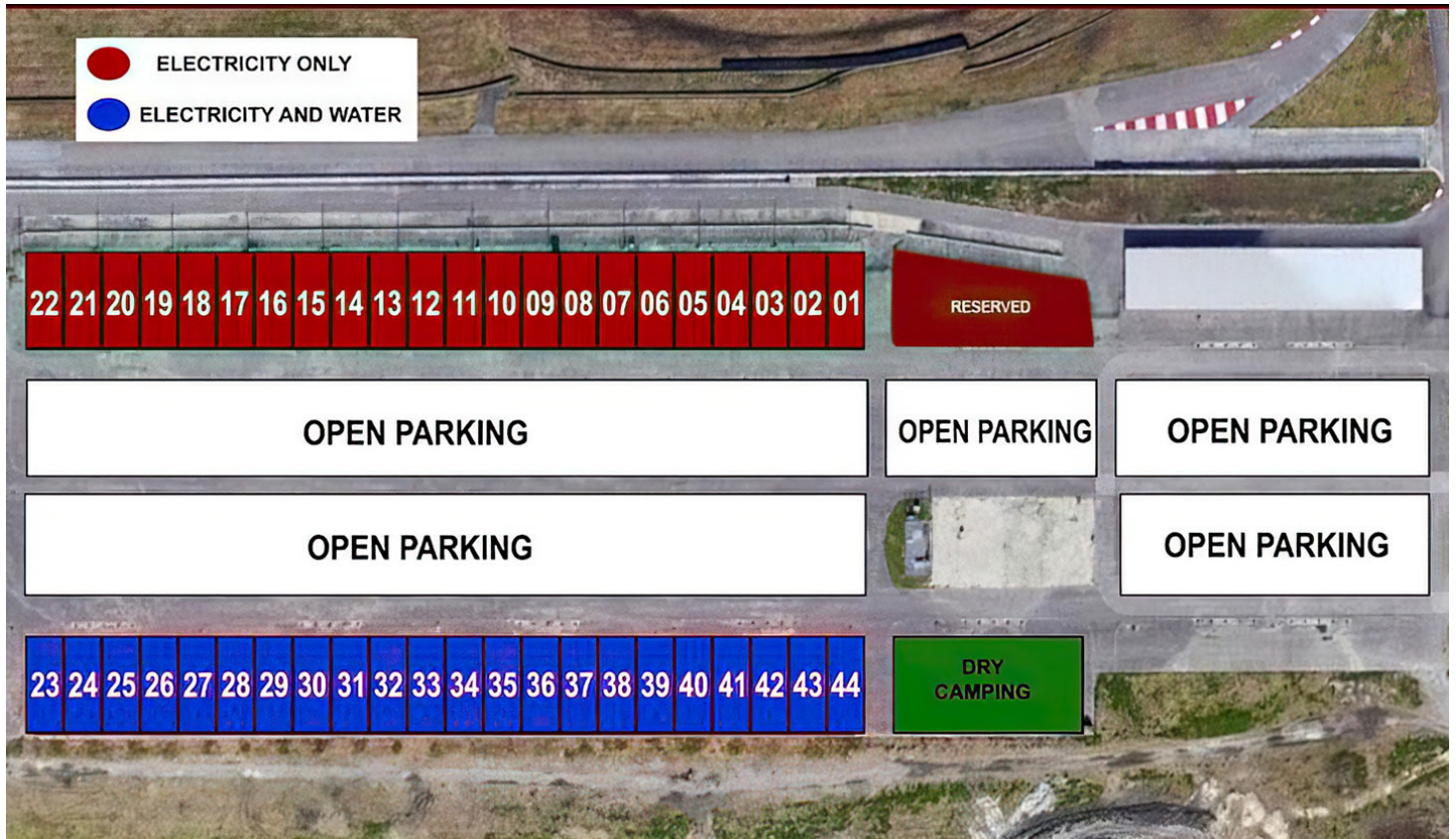
