EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

ESN 1 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR. **Mufflers are required at Hallett.**

ESN 2 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage. Tire walls charged at \$100 per hour to fix.

ESN 3 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 4 - Flagtronics will be available for rent at \$50 per event weekend. Available at Race Central / Registration.

ESN 5 - All ChampCar decals must be installed prior to tech inspection. No exception. <https://rvagfx.com/store/>

Technical Information

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft.

Paddock Speed Limit: 10mph

Waste Oil: Waste oil and other petroleum-based liquid must ONLY be placed in disposal collection containers at the track fuel station.

Paddock Electric: The electric service jacks/boxes located throughout the paddock area are for the temporary and casual use of the customer (e.g. personal computer, small fan). They are NOT for heavy power uses such as electric service to trucks, vans, trailers, motor homes, etc. without purchase. Pay for your HMRC electric service at the Tower's first floor within 5 minutes of plugging in or run a generator, which requires a muffler and functionality within reasonable levels of sound.

Pitlane Electric: None.

Lighting: There are no electrical hookups in the pit or paddock. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Hallett premises are subject to video surveillance.

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members.

Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you paddock and cold pit lane access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

Pets: While not an absolute prohibition, it is requested that pets not be brought to the circuit. If pet owners must bring their pets, all pets must be on a leash and attended by a responsible keeper at all times unless they are left properly secured in a vehicle.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road. The playground in Martin Park is only for children supervised by adults, not for pets. Supervise all minors.
