EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

- ESN 1 Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR. Mufflers are required at NCM. Friday NCM Test Day teams will be notified if they are over the 96dbA limit.
- ESN 2 Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.
- ESN 3 Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.
- ESN 4 The required Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display will be available rent. \$50 at registration. Transponders are also available to rent at registration for \$50.
- ESN 5 Headlights are required on the race cars per the 2023 BCCR. Lights may be required to be turned on during inclement weather.

Technical Information

Driver & Crew: Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband and helmet decal from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the Online Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display: This information is subject to change.

Required starting June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. Limited quantities available at registration. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at https://htmpcar.org/ntmpcar

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft. See next column for more details.

Unrestricted Advanced: Pass anywhere no point by (this group is

typically for our Licensed Competition Drivers)

Each run group gets 30 min sessions and an hour at the end of the day. The hour at the end of the day is structured like our Advanced group (pass anywhere with point by)

Intermediate gets 4 sessions 30min sessions, Advanced and Unrestricted Advance get 5 30min sessions, all 3 get to participate in the happy hour (Final Count Down) at the end. This gives drivers up to 3.5hours of test and tune time!!

We do allow teams to share a car in the same run group. There is special pricing if the teams want to run in two or all three groups (as long as they follow the rules in the group they are in at the time).

Event & Venue Information

Garages: Garages can be rented from VIR. Contact VIR at http://virnow.com/lodging/garages/

Do not park in front of a garage unless you have rented a garage.

Paddock Electric: Very limited. Generators are recommended. Must reserve and pay through VIR. -\$35 for the weekend.

Pitlane Electric: None. Bring generators.

Lighting: Very limited. The paddock and pit lane get really dark. Bring lights. Did we mention it gets dark? VIR will be the darkest place you have ever raced.

Pets: Pets allowed into the track must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Pet access is a privilege not a right. The track reserves the right to deny pet access to the property at any time.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road.

Camping / Camper Hookups: Premium RV spots, reserve through VIR. Camping Rates (Camping Fee does not include power):

Tent - \$35 (This includes car trailers without any type of living facility)

RV's (driven or towed) - \$50 (This includes car trailers with any type of living facility)

*A RV used as a "tow" vehicle will be charged the RV camping fee

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the paddock area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. / Yes.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: Yes. VIR Consessions will be open during business hours

Access Roads: Absolutely no Testing, Cool Downs, Brake Bedding or Speeding is permitted on the Access Roads at any time. This activity is restricted to the race track only.

Fuel on site: Sonoco Fuels. Credit card pumps on site. No diesel.

- 93 unleaded which may contain up to 10% ethanol.
- 98 unleaded (260 GTX) which is ethanol-free (for offroad and racing applications only).
- 100 unleaded which may contain up to 10% ethanol.
- 110 leaded which is ethanol-free (for off-road and racing applications only).

Disposal of Waste Fluid and Environmental Debris: Use of the Safety Kleen waste drums is mandatory for used oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, and other polluting material. Spillage will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the facility. Participants must remove all used tires, batteries and unwanted parts. Environmental debris left behind will result in fines to the team based on cleanup costs.

VIR does not permit Chlorinated Brake Cleaner on property.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather. Prepare for rain, heat, and high humidity.

Off-Road Vehicle Policy: ATVs, golf carts and other off-road vehicles must be licensed by VIR. They must have lights, brakes and a hand controlled steering system. Owners must purchase a license/permit for a fee of \$30, which is valid for the current

season. Licenses/permits can be purchased at the front entrance gate.

Right of Way: Drivers of any non-racing vehicle will yield the right of way to any Race Vehicle at all times. Due to the constraints of safety equipment and vehicle design, drivers of racing vehicles may have limited visibility or mobility while operating their vehicle. Operators of racing vehicles will obey posted speed limits and traffic control devices to include instructions from VIR Security Staff.


