EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

ESN 1 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR.

ESN 2 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 3 - Event Sponsor Decal installation instructions - none

ESN 4 - RED FLAG Quiet 2-Hour - NEW for 2022. Due to agreements with local church, there will be a 2-hour quiet time for lunch on Sunday.

ESN 5 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 6 - The required Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display will be available rent. \$50 at registration. Transponders are also available to rent at registration for \$50.

ESN 7 - Headlights are required on the race cars per the 2023 BCCR. Lights may be required to be turned on during inclement weather.

Technical Information

Driver & Crew: Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband and helmet decal from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form. The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration. Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:
This information is subject to change.

Required starting June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. Limited quantities available at registration. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar>

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft. See next column for more details.

Venue Specific Information

Test & Tune Information: Space is limited, pre-registration is mandatory. This event is open to Champ car Teams and Advanced Drivers only, 40 min ChampCar run group and 20 min Advanced run group each hour. fire suits are not required but long pants are closed toed shoes are. Paddock Electric: Gingerman Electric Fee

Thursday - Sunday: \$80

Friday - Sunday: \$60

Or bring generators if power is needed. The paddock gets VERY dark.

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/ paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Garages: Garages are for rent. Call 269-253-4445

Quiet Time: The local churches and township are now requiring us to give them a 2-hour quiet period on Sunday from 10am to 12pm.

RED FLAG Quiet Hour Procedures: At 9:45am pit lane will be closed. The race will be red-flagged at 10:00am. All cars will be brought down pit lane. All work must stop on cars in the pit and paddock.

Drivers will exit cars, and you may remove in-car data cards/cameras. No work will be allowed on the cars.

You may cover your car.

Drivers will be called back to the cars at 11:45 pm. You may only re-insert data cards and cameras, and add ice to your cool suit boxes when the race restarts.

Driver stints reset.

Race cars can be restarted at 12:00pm or when directed by ChampCar staff.

The pace car will lead the field out of pit lane, and come in after one lap. You must do one lap before you can pit, unless car is broke on pit lane, then you can start your pit stop after the cars on track have taken the green flag.

Event Info

Weekend Membership Passes: Cannot go over the wall, \$20 for the weekend at registration. Over the wall crew must be full ChampCar club members.

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members. Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you spectator and cold pit lane access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

Pets: They are welcome on property, but must be kept on a leash. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets and must dispose of their waste properly. Pets are not allowed in the cold pits.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road.

Camping: Self contained \$10 per day through Gingerman Raceway. Kids 12 and under are free.

Camping / Camper Hookups: Self contained RV and tent camping allowed. \$10 per day through Gingerman Raceway. 30amp hookups available. Generators are recommended.

Gingerman Electric Fee
Thursday - Sunday: \$80
Friday - Sunday: \$60

Barbecues: Paddock and camping areas only. Not allowed on pit road. BBQ's are allowed in the camping and paddock parking area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. / Yes.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: Yes. Concessions is open during business hours.

Fuel on site: Yes. Pay cash or credit at the gift shop. 93, 100, 110 octanes.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

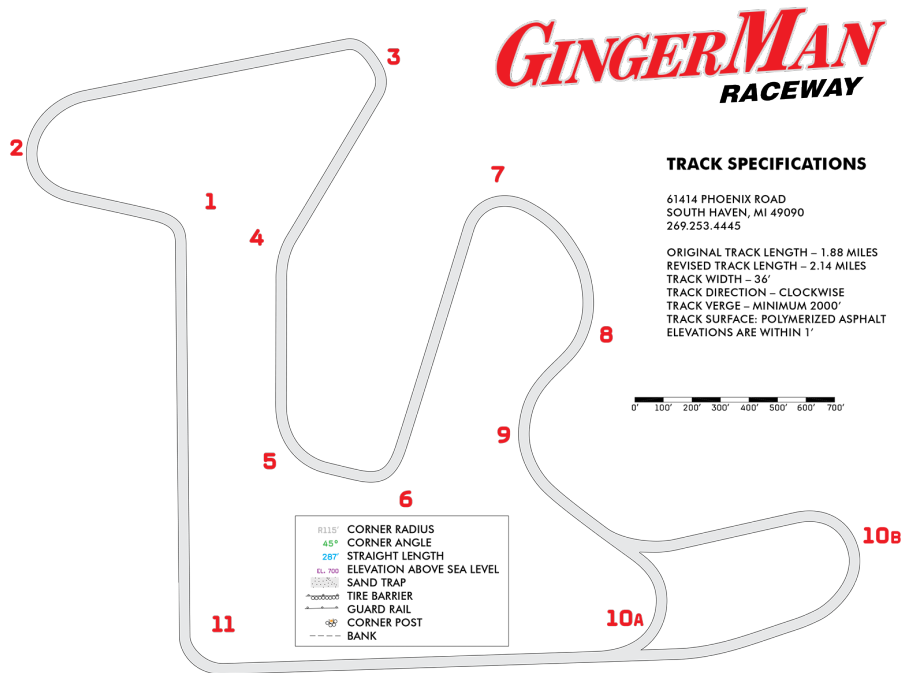
