EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

ESN 1 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR. Mufflers are required at Road America.

ESN 2 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 3 - Event Sponsor Decal installation instructions - None

ESN 4 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 5 - Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display will be available to rent. They are required per the BCCR.

ESN 6 - Road America is hosting a Trunk-or-Treat event during our race weekend. Please review the maps for no-go areas such as parking. Do not enter track at the false grid, please enter at pit-in next to the Race Control Access tunnel.

Please keep your paddock speeds at or below 15mph and be aware there may be children and non-race event people around.

Technical Information

Driver & Crew: Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband from registration after showing your government issued ID Card. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form. The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration. Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display: This information is subject to change. Required starting June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. Limited quantities available at registration. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar>

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft. See next column for more details.

Overnight Stays / Camping / Electric Fees: RV camping, Race Trailer Camping, Tent Camping includes choice of top lot with 50 amp electric or paddock electric, 1 pit lane electric band. - \$125

Overnight stays, Tent camping, no electric - \$100

Pitlane electric weekend ONLY - **FREE**. You may not power your campers with pit lane power.

Track Access: No one is allowed access to the track after operations hours for any reason, i.e., running, walking, etc.

Waiver and Wristbands: ALL drivers and crew must report to the ticket window at registration to sign the waiver and receive a waiver wristband. You will not be allowed access to the track without this wristband.

Pit vehicles: There will be a \$25 Pit Vehicle Pass for golf carts, scooters, etc. Golf Carts are available to rent from Road America. <https://www.roadamerica.com/golf-carts> SEGWAYS, HOVERBOARDS, ONEWHEELS, ROLLERBLADES, NON-MOTORIZED & MOTORIZED SKATEBOARDS AND ROLLER SKATES are not permitted on Road America property. BICYCLES are permitted but may not be ridden in the COMPETITION PADDOCK AREA - this is strictly PROHIBITED.

Garages: Garages are available for rent. They are \$550 for the weekend and can accommodate more than one car. Contact Road America for details. 920-892-4576

Paddock: Limited lighting. One space per team. Included with your race entry fee. Operators of all motor vehicles (including golf cars) must possess a valid state-issued driver's license. At no time is anyone allowed to park in fire lanes. Violators will be towed.

Pitlane Electric: ChampCar will be selling power hookups for pit road during registration at the ticket counter. \$50 for electric on pit road.

Pit Lane Heaters: Heaters on pit lane are not allowed.

Media Information

Lighting: The pit lane is not lit . Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for night time mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources.

R/A premises are subject to video surveillance.

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members. Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you spectator and cold pit lane access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

Pets: Pets are not allowed on Road America properties.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road. Minors between 16-18 years old who are ChampCar members with a completed Minor Waiver and who are registered to participate can attend. Children must be under adult supervision at all times

Barbecues: No open campfires or barrel fires are allowed. Only contained, manufactured barbeques and grills are permitted.

Restroom / Showers: Yes / Yes - in the main paddock restrooms near the roundabout.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: Concessions will be open. Limited hours.

Fuel on site: Fuel is available for purchase via credit card at all club events. To gain access to the pumps, purchasers need to be participants who are registered in an event that is taking place. There are two types of fuel available: Sunoco, 110 octane, (leaded), and 98 octane (unleaded).

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

Drones: No drones or unmanned aircraft systems are allowed. Violators in possession or operation at any time will be subject to confiscation of their unmanned aircraft, immediate removal from the property, and further prosecution by Law Enforcement.

Photo/Media Credentials: There will be a limit as to how many credentials are issued. Cut-off for event credentials is 2-Weeks before event start. All track side photographers must be full ChampCar Members. Please visit

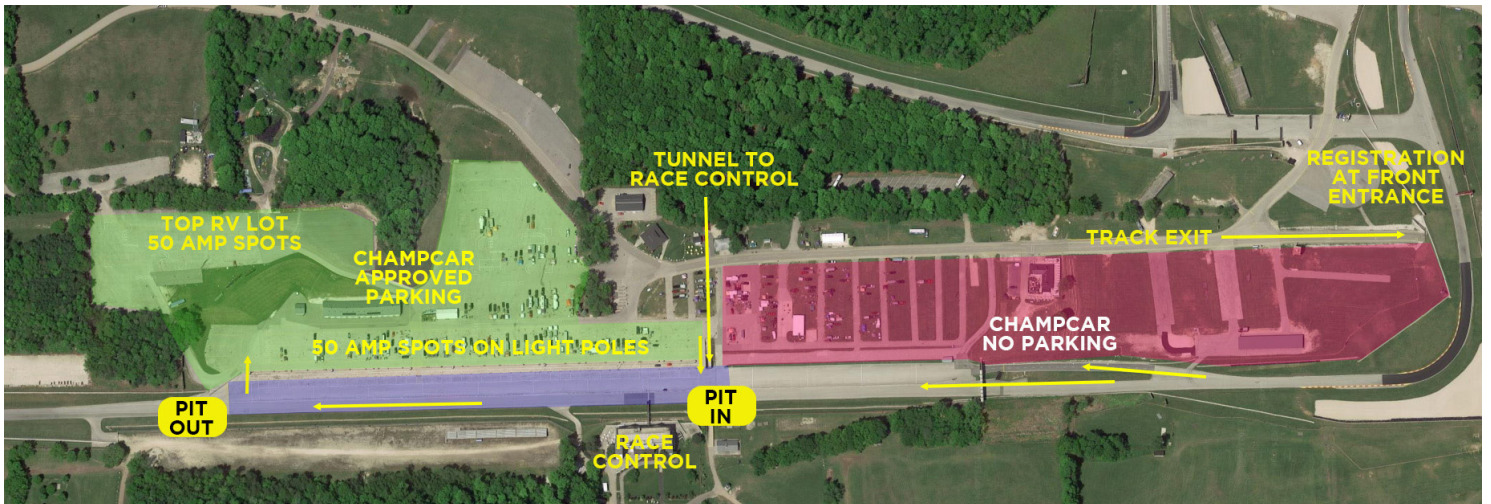
