#### **EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES**

ESN 1 - Headlights are required on the race cars per the 2023 BCCR. Lights may be required to be turned on during inclement weather.

ESN 2 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR.

ESN 3 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 4 - Event Sponsor Decal installation instructions - None

ESN 5 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 6 - The required Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display will be available rent. \$50 at registration. Transponders are also available to rent at registration for \$50.

#### **Technical Information**

**Driver & Crew:** Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband and helmet decal from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

**Race Car Tech Inspection:** All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

#### Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:

This information is subject to change. Required starting June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. Limited quantities available at registration. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at https:/flagtronics.com/champcar

**Fire Bottle:** Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

**Sound:** Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft. See next column for more details.

**Quiet Hours –** Quiet hours for the entire VIR Property are from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. This includes all lodging, camping and Industrial areas. VIR asks that all guests be considerate of others and not play loud music. Any music that is determined to be a nuisance by VIR Security must be turned down or off. Un-muffled engines (vehicles) must not be run between 8:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m

**Garages:** VIR has 18 Paddock Garages on site. Garages include the Paddock space for one trailer to park directly in front of the reserved garage. Refueling or storage of any fuel is not permitted in the garages. Sleeping/Overnight stays are not permitted in the Garages; the Pit Lane Room above each garage is available for an additional fee. For reservations, call 434-822-7700 x300. Anyone in violation of storing fuel, refueling or sleeping in the garages may lose access to their garage with no refunds.

**Paddock:** ChampCar will be using the VIR North Paddock.

**Electric:** Any Participant wanting to use a VIR receptacle for electricity must pay a \$40 fee per Event per plug in. VIR Club Members are entitled to one paddock electrical hookup per event at no charge based upon availability. Participants are issued a specific Power Band for the Event. The Power Band will be secured around the electrical cord end that plugs into the power source. At various times during events, Security Personnel will check for Power Bands. Those cables without the proper band will be disconnected from the power source. VIR encourages all Participants to utilize a power generator whenever possible. Additionally, if you utilize Paddock space and are using a generator, we request that you park on the outer edges of the grid to allow access for those purchasing electricity. If there are issues with power pedestals contact VIR Security or Maintenance. Tampering with the pedestals is prohibited. Please report any damage to power boxes and outlets before you utilize the service so you are not charged.

Pitlane Electric: Pit lane has electric and lighting.

Pit Lane Heaters: Heaters on pit lane are not allowed.

**Access Roads -** Absolutely no Testing, Cool Downs, Brake Bedding, Burnouts or Speeding is permitted on the Access Roads at any time. This activity is restricted to the race track only.

The Supplemental Rules May Be Updated Without Notice. Teams Are Advised To Check Them With Regularity And Print A Copy For Reference Prior To Coming To The Event.

**Bicycles -** Children are not permitted to ride bikes, rollerblades, skates, skate-boards and scooters in the Paddock during hot track hours. Children may be permitted to ride them at the end of the day if they do so safely. **Hover boards or single wheeled vehicles are not permitted for use at VIR at any time.** 

**Disposal of Waste Fluid and Environmental Debris** – Use of the Safety Kleen waste drums is mandatory for used oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, and other polluting material. Spillage will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the facility. Participants must remove all used tires, batteries and unwanted parts. Environmental debris left behind will result in fines to the Renter based on cleanup costs. VIR does not permit Chlorinated Brake Cleaner on property.

**Guest & Pit Passes:** All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members.
Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you spectator and cold pit lane access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

**Pets:** They are welcome on property, but must be kept on a leash. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets and must dispose of their waste properly. Pets are not allowed in the cold pits.

**Children:** No children under-18 allowed on pit road. Minors between 16-18 years old who are ChampCar members with a completed Minor Waiver and who are registered to participate can attend.

**Camping:** Self-contained RV camping is allowed Friday & Saturday night. Must be out by 7pm Sunday.

**Camping / Camper Hookups:** There are no hookups, and only one or two power pole hookups. These get taken fast so bring a generator.

**Barbecues:** BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

**Restroom / Showers:** Yes. / Yes. Showers and restrooms are located in the North Paddock.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

**Concessions:** North Course Concessions will operate from 7 am-5 pm Friday and Saturday.

**Fuel on site:** Credit card pumps available in the north paddock

**Weather:** We're racing, regardless of the weather.

**Drones:** Unmanned aircraft systems and drones are prohibited at ChampCar Endurance events at all times.


