#### **EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES**

**ESN 1 - NO TESTING OF YOUR CARS ON THE HIGHWAY 36. YOU WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE EVENT IF YOU DO THIS.**

ESN 2 - Must sign HPR waiver at gate, and wear HPR wristband all weekend.

ESN 3 - Lights are required on the race cars per the BCCR.

ESN 4 - Max sound of 96dba at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR.

ESN 5 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 6 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 7 - Passenger seats must be removed for the race.

### Technical Information

**ATTENTION:** All vehicles, drivers, and crew must meet the safety and equipment requirements of the [2024 BCCR](#).

Stint maximum of 2 hours per driver with a minimum of 1 hour between stints.

All fueling is to be completed on pitlane race day.

**Driver & Crew Waiver and Gear Check Agreement:** Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband and helmet decal from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

**Race Car Tech Inspection:** All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics FT-200 serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

**Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:**

Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar>

Code35 will be in use at all ChampCar events.

As ChampCar test the timing and scoring capabilities with the Flagtronics FT-200, it is imperative that your FT200 unit and the GPS is mounted within the rules and that the unit is working.

**Fire Bottle:** Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

**Sound:** Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft.

**Alcohol:** Absolutely no alcohol may be consumed in the Paddock during the day's racing events.

**Track Elevation:** Highest point 5054 feet above sea level

### Venue Specific Information

**NOTE:** Testing, tuning, brake bedding, high speed accelerations or braking will be limited to the track, and not allowed in the paddock or surround public roadways. Doing so could result in event expulsion with no fees returned.

**2024 Tech Inspection:** Please complete your Web-based tech form and the car ready for safety inspection by ChampCar tech staff. Please have your number panels installed. All teams will be given new 2024 sponsor panels. They must be installed at Tech.

Dry camping is no charge, first come first serve, there is plenty of room.

**Paddock & Electric:** Electric is only available in the carports and RV spaces. Do not drive stakes or nails into the asphalt. Stakes may be driven into unpaved areas only with location specific authorization from track management. There are underground utilities, and you will be charged for any repairs to utilities or the asphalt.

**Pitlane Electric:** Yes, along the hot pit wall. There are regularly spaced outlets along the pit wall, but less than one per stall so you'll need to share!

**Lighting:** Lighting only in the carports. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for night time mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources.

**Guest & Pit Passes:** All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members.

Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you spectator and cold pit lane access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

**Pets:** Pets allowed into the track must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Pet access is a privilege not a right. The track reserves the right to deny pet access to the property at any time.

### Nearby Lodging

**Barbecues:** No open campfires or barrel fires are allowed. Only contained, manufactured barbecues and grills are permitted.

**Children:** No children under-18 allowed on pit road. Minors between 16-18 years old who are ChampCar members with a completed Minor Waiver and who are registered to participate can attend. Small children may not be left unattended.

**Restroom / Showers:** There are flush toilets and sinks in the restroom trailer, and showers and sinks in the shower trailer (both closed during the winter months to avoid freeze damage). There are also portable toilets throughout the paddock. Because we must truck in all of our water, at this time there is no other running water (for filling buckets, RV's, washing cars, etc) at HPR. There is a KOA located 20 minutes away in Strasburg where you can fill/dump for a small fee.

**Venue Cellular and Wi-Fi:** There is good cellular coverage from AT&T and great coverage from Verizon. There is Wi-Fi available throughout the paddock provided by Vistabeam.com. Look for wireless access points labeled "Vistabeam".

**Gate:** 24-hour gate coverage

**Non-street legal race vehicles:** Pit bikes, scooters, etc. may be operated on HPR property only. Anyone found to be operating non-street legal vehicles on highway 36 will be removed from the property for the balance of the event.

**WARNING:** Alcohol may not be consumed by anyone anywhere on HPR property until the track surface is closed ("cold") at the end of the day. Marijuana possession and/or use is not permitted at any time. Illegal drug possession and/or use is not permitted at any time.

An invoice will be sent to the team captain. Payment plans can be worked out if needed. Unpaid track damage invoices could result in a membership hold until paid. Subject to change.





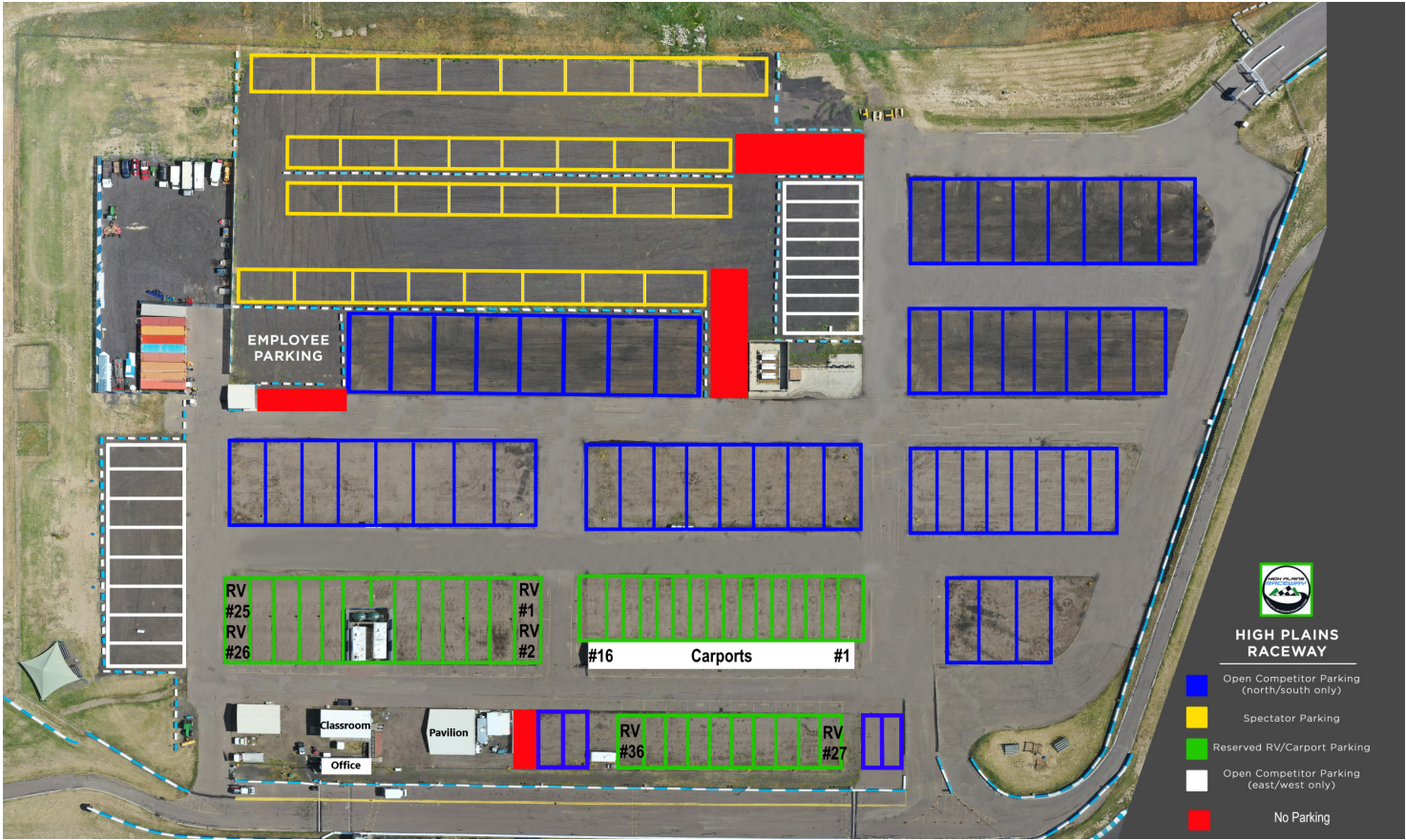
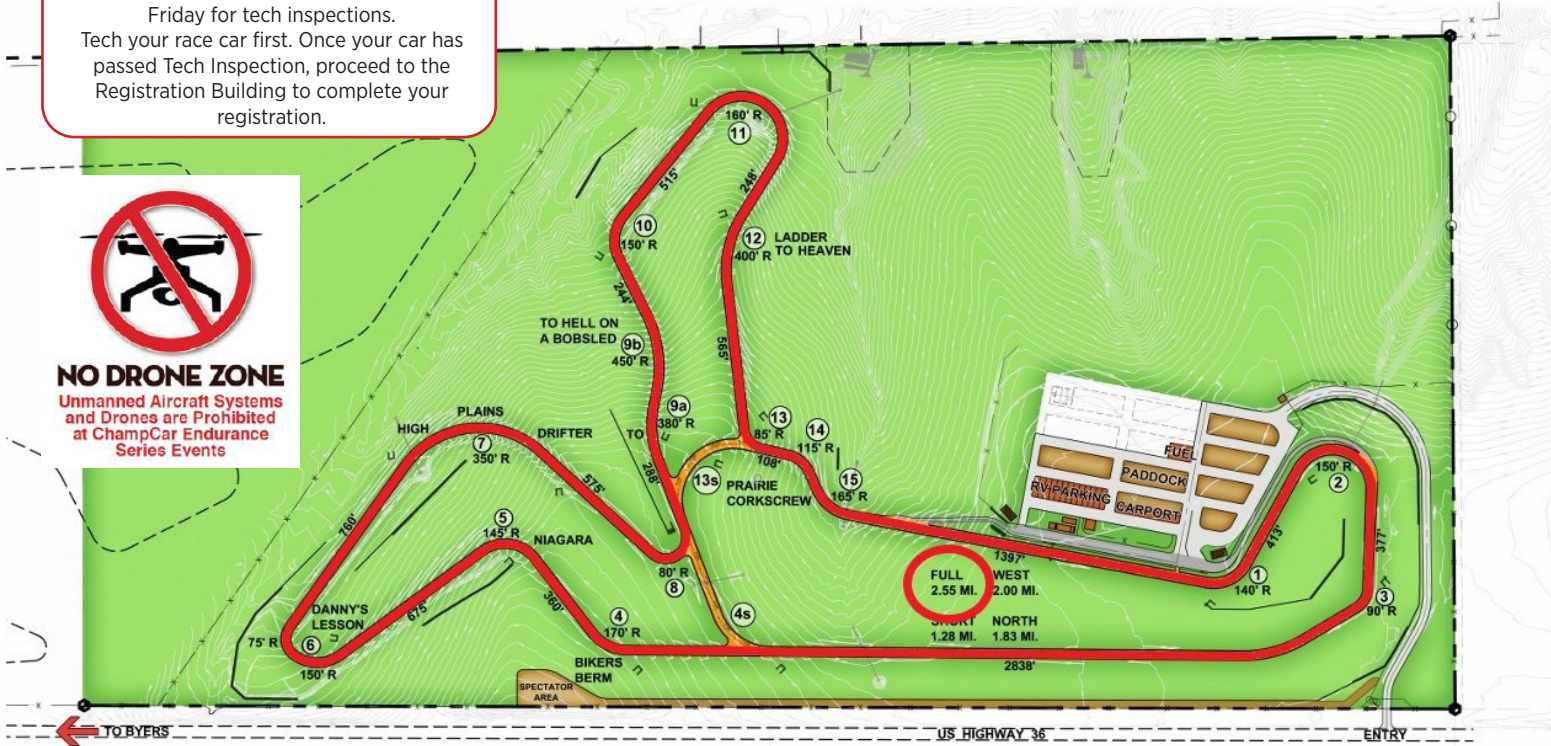
