TECH LINE REQUIREMENTS

- Have all decals installed as per the BCCR. Get sponsor decal at tech.
- Owned Flagtronics installed per BCCR and working. ChampCar will test at tech. Teams responsibility to have the correct V.0.8.X.X firmware.
- Owned Transponder installed and working. ChampCar will test at tech.
- Flagtronics and Transponder rentals will be issued to teams at Tech.
- All lights for night racing installed and working. They will be tested.
- Electronic tech form completed.

Not having the current ChampCar firmware installed on the Flagtronics FT200 will get your car black flagged to update. No exceptions.

Technical Information

ATTENTION: All vehicles, drivers, and crew must meet the safety and equipment requirements of the [2025 BCCR](#).

Stint maximum of 2 hours per driver with a minimum of 1 hour between stints.

All fueling is to be completed on pitlane race day.

Driver & Crew Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The team captain will log in here <https://champcar.org/register/login.php> to complete the race car online tech form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics FT-200 serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:

Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar>

Code35 will be in use at all ChampCar events.

As ChampCar test the timing and scoring capabilities with the Flagtronics FT-200, it is imperative that your FT200 unit and the GPS is mounted within the rules and that the unit is working. **The FT-200 must be mounted on the dash so it can be seen by pit lane staff.**

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft. Sound test takes place between T3 and T4 drivers left.

Alcohol: Absolutely no alcohol may be consumed in the Paddock during the day's racing events. Alcohol may be consumed 30 minutes following the completion of on-track activity for the day.

Venue Specific Information

NOTE: Testing, tuning, brake bedding, high speed accelerations or braking will be limited to the track, and not allowed in the paddock or surround public roadways. Doing so could result in event expulsion with no fees returned.

Track Access: No one is allowed access to the track after operations hours for any reason, i.e., running, walking, etc.

Garages: Garages are available for \$125. Purchase these when you register for the event. Email the event director if you want a garage after you register. Garages include electric and your assigned trailer spot. Remember that the garages are separated into Yellow and Blue. Pay close attention to your emails for assignments. Space is limited. Parking location for personal vehicles will be added to the supps closer to the event. **Garage areas are locked at 7:00pm Friday and will be unlocked at 5:00am Saturday. Infield access is open 24 hours.**

Paddock: Paddock will be both Blue and Yellow garage areas. Your garage number will be marked on your assigned parking spot in sidewalk chalk. Only your tow vehicle and trailer are allowed in the parking spot. Teams without a garage will be parked east of the Yellow Garages, overflow trailer lot. See map on page 4, Trailer Parking Drop Off Area.

Garage areas are locked at 7:00pm Friday and will be unlocked at 5:00am Saturday. Infield access is open 24 hours.

No electric. Limited lighting. One space per team. At no time is anyone allowed to park in fire lanes. Violators will be towed.

Pitlane Electric: Electrical hookups are limited along pitlane.

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Pitlane Speed: 20 mph at all times. GPS/Flagtronics and Radar Gun enforced.

Radio Frequencies: The ChampCar radio frequencies are reserved for ChampCar official use only and must not be used by the track or teams during the event. Monitor the [Race Logs](#)

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Venue Specific Information

Clothing: Closed toed shoes are required on pitlane and over the wall. Per the BCCR, no shorts allowed in the hot pit lane.

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members.

Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you paddock and cold pit lane access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

Pets: To make sure we are offering all of our guests the best experience possible we ask pet owners to follow these policies. All pets must stay within your assigned camping spot, pets are not permitted in garages; do not walk pets along roadways. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after pets and must dispose of the waste properly. Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Please respect your neighbors. Excessive barking or aggressiveness is not permitted.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road. Minors between 16-18 years old who are ChampCar members with a completed Minor Waiver and who are registered to participate can attend. Children must be under adult supervision at all times

Camping / RV Hookups: Available at Lake Lloyd Shores. Included with your \$100 camping fee. No reservations. First come, first parked. Lake Loyd area has hookups. Paddock area does not have hookups. No reservations. First come, first parked. Pumpouts are \$50 cash. The number for the RV pump outs is #904-304-0766. The plan is to have the truck come thru the infield Friday and Saturday at 7pm but they must be present at their motorhome to flag down the driver.

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Showers and bathrooms are open.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage

Concessions: Will be open during normal hours.

Fuel on site: Not available on site. Fuel is available at various stations outside of the track. Race fuel may be available at these stations. Used oil and petroleum waste dump is located near the Daytona fuel pumps.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather. Cloud to cloud, and cloud to ground lightning within 10 miles will start a process of bringing all of the cars into the pitlane. The race will be red flagged. Get the drivers out of the cars, and all crew and drivers must exit pitlane and get to cover. DO NOT use your easy up as cover. The garages or your trailer are the best areas for cover.

Drones: Unmanned aircraft systems and drones are prohibited at ChampCar Endurance events at all times.

Last Lap Procedure: DO NOT cross over the pit lane wall. All competitors MUST remain on the cold pit side of the wall unless working on a car on pit lane.

ATV / Golf Carts: No personal golf carts are allowed.

Other Vehicles: No ATVs, carts, roller-blades, motorized skateboard or bicycles are allowed on DIS property.

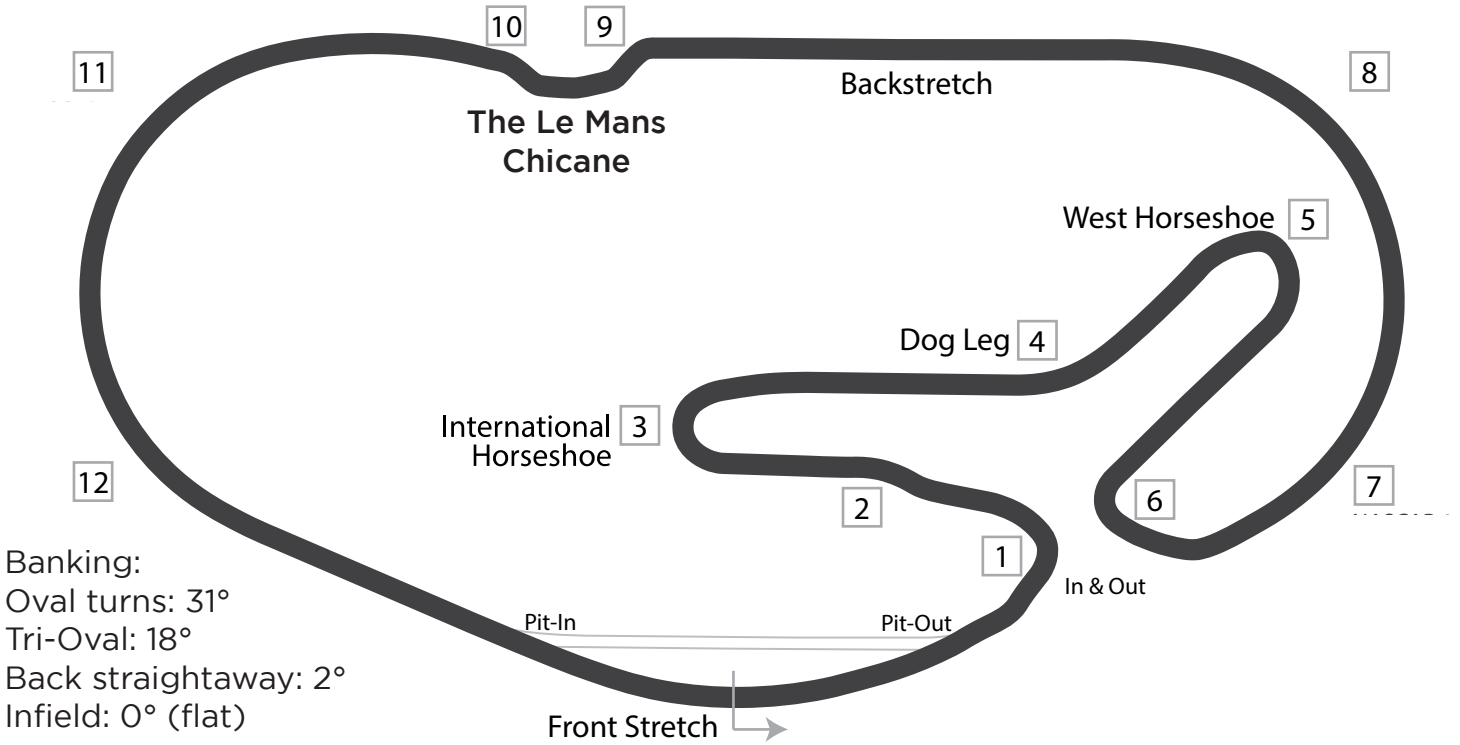

Yellow = Yellow Garage **Lavender - Truck Pad** **Do not park on grass**

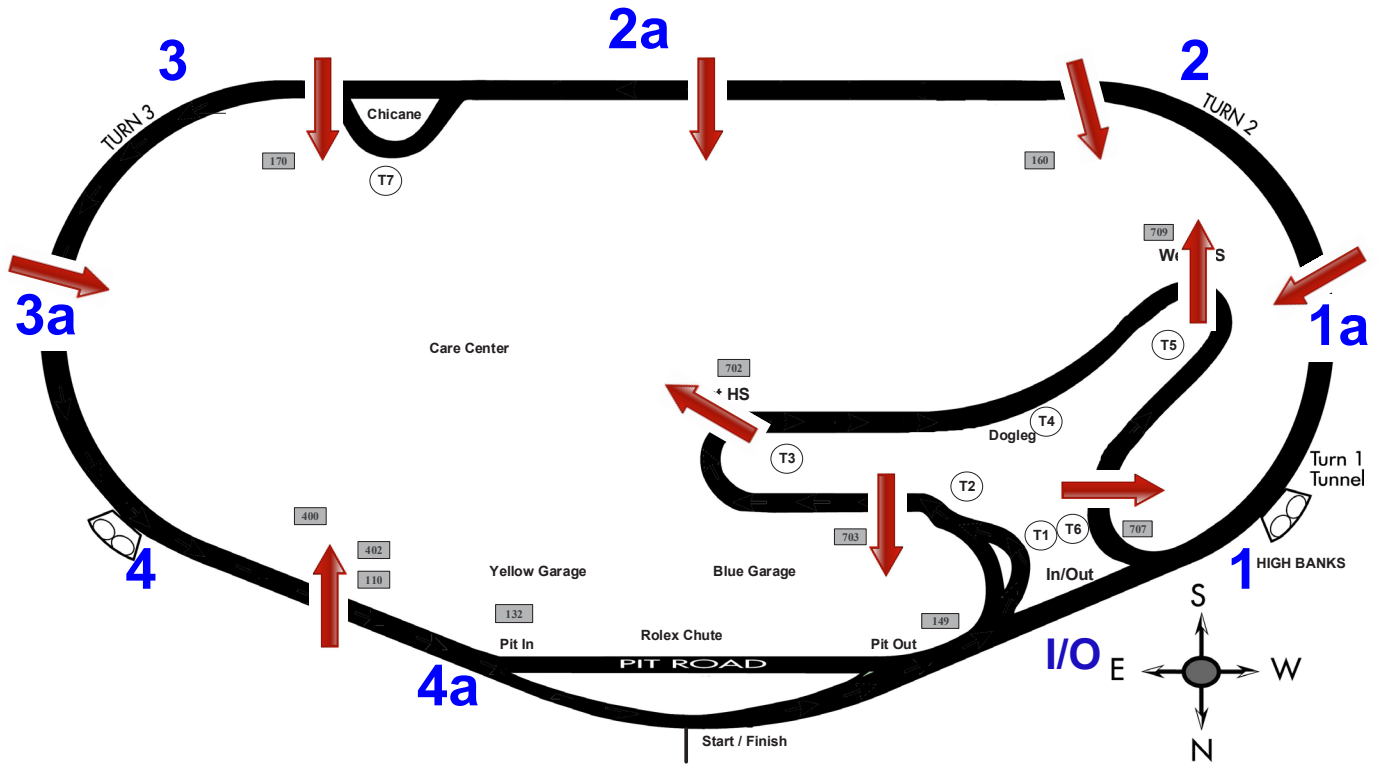
