#### **EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES**

ESN 1 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR.

ESN 2 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage. Track limits will be enforced.

ESN 3 - Flagtronics will be available for rent at \$50 per event weekend. Available at Race Central / Registration.

ESN 4 - Photo/Media Credentials: Cut-off for event credentials is 2-Weeks before event start. Please visit https://champcar.org/web/media.

ESN 5 - Passenger seat must be removed for the race.

ESN 8 - Headlights must be white or yellow in color. Brake lights and rear tail lights must be red and clearly seen by the corner workers.

#### **Technical Information**

**ATTENTION:** All vehicles, drivers, and crew must meet the safety and equipment requirements of the 2025 BCCR. Stint maximum of 2 hours per driver with a minimum of 1 hour between stints. All fueling is to be completed on pitlane race day. Absolutely no fueling in the garages. Do not store fuel in the garages.

Driver & Crew Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

**Race Car Tech Inspection:** All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration. Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics FT-200 serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display: Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <a href="https://index.com/">https://index.com/</a> champcar

Code35 will be in use at all ChampCar events. As ChampCar test the timing and scoring capabilities with the Flagtronics FT-200, it is imperitive that your FT200 unit and the GPS is mounted within the rules and that the unit is working.

**Sound:** Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft.

**Track Access:** No one is allowed access to the track after operations hours for any reason, i.e., running, walking, etc.

Waiver and Wristbands: ALL drivers and crew must report to the ticket window at registration to sign the waiver and receive a waiver wristband. You will not be allowed access to the track without this wristband.

#### **Venue Specific Information**

**Pit vehicles:** There will be a \$25 Pit Vehicle Pass for golf carts, scooters, etc. Golf Carts are available to rent from Road America. <a href="https://www.roadamerica.com/golf-carts">https://www.roadamerica.com/golf-carts</a>

SEGWAYS, HOVERBOARDS, ONEWHEELS, ROLLERBLADES, NON-MOTORIZED & MOTORIZED SKATEBOARDS AND ROLLER SKATES are not permitted on Road America property. BICYCLES are permitted but may not be ridden in the COMPETITION PADDOCK AREA – this is strictly PROHIBITED. Operators of all motor vehicles (including golf cars) must possess a valid state-issued driver's license.

**Paddock:** Limited lighting. One space per team. Included with your race entry fee. Operators of all motor vehicles (including golf cars) must possess a valid state-issued driver's license. At no time is anyone allowed to park in fire lanes. Violators will be towed.

**Pitlane Electric:** ChampCar will be selling power hookups for pit road during registration at the ticket counter. \$50 for electric on pit road.

**Pit Lane Heaters:** Heaters on pit lane are not allowed.

**Lighting:** The pit lane is not lit. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for night time mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources.

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members. Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you spectator and cold pit lane access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

**Pets:** Pets are not allowed on Road America properties.

**Children:** No children under-18 allowed on pit road. Minors between 16-18 years old who are ChampCar members with a completed Minor Waiver and who are registered to participate can attend. Children must be under adult supervision at all times

**Barbecues:** No open campfires or barrel fires are allowed. Only contained, manufactured barbeques and grills are permitted.

**Restroom / Showers:** Yes / Yes - in the main paddock restrooms near the roundabout.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

**Concessions:** Consessions will be open. Limited hours.

**Fuel on site:** Fuel is available for purchase via credit card at all club events. To gain access to the pumps, purchasers need to be participants who are registered in an event that is taking place. There are two types of fuel available: Sunoco, 110 octane, (leaded), and 98 octane (unleaded).

**Weather:** We're racing, regardless of the weather.

**Shipping:** Teams shall understand that there will be a handling fee of \$5 for every package shipped to

R/A to be collected prior to release of the package. There will also be a minimum charge of \$65 for all shipments that need to be unloaded by R/A personnel, using R/A equipment.

A fee of \$100 per hour will be charged if you need the skid moved to your location. Packages must be labeled:

**Drones:** No drones or unmanned aircraft systems are allowed. Violators in possession or operation at any time will be subject to confiscation of their unmanned aircraft, immediate removal from the property, and further prosecution by Law Enforcement.

**Photo/Media Credentials:** There will be a limit as to how many credentials are issued. Cut-off for event credentials is 2-Weeks before event start. All track side photograpghers must be full ChampCar Members.



## Event Supplementals Race Car Decals


Per the ChampCar BCCR, the following examples are approved installation locations for the required ChampCar decal package.

Order decal packages with printed numbers at <a href="https://rvagfx.com/store">https://rvagfx.com/store</a> Please allow 3-4 weeks before your event as shipping may be slow.

Don't wait until the last minute to order.




Sponsor and number panels must be attached between the arrows as shown. Sponsors may be cut out of the white background but must remain in the same order and be applied in the vertical style as shown. It would be best to plan your graphic style around the number/sponsor panel placement. Per the BCCR, numbers on all number panels shall be black and at minimum 8.0" tall. Fonts shall be a minimum of 1.0" broad (brush stroke) and a maximum of 1.5" wide.



A roof/hood number panel may still be used, but are no longer required. Per the BCCR, numbers on all number panels shall be black and at minimum 8.0" tall. Fonts shall be a minimum of 1.0" broad (brush stroke) and a maximum of 1.5" wide.



TireRack retains exclusive rights to placement at the top of the windshield region. No additional text or logos are permitted within a 6-inch range above or below the TireRack name. While the background is discretionary, it should not be white, orange, or yellow as specified by the BCCR. The TireRack letters must be in white. Vehicles lacking front windshields are required to display a decal at the top of the hood. The TireRack letter size should be 100mm/4" tall, and their orientation can be adjusted to suit the curvature of the windshield.



Class/Number bumper decal must be attached to the car's front and rear as shown between the arrows. For the front decal, pick a place facing forward.



All decals shown on the left image must be applied to your ChampCar before you tech the car and start the race event. Teams may use a ChampCar supplied white die-cut TireRack window decal. Any missing decals can delay the start of your race.

ChampCar Tech will have a limited number of blank number panels for sale along with free sponsor panels, TireRack window die-cut banners, class letter decal, and a blank rear bumper class decal.

The number panel design will allow you to remove the top and lower Sponsor/ChampCar sections if you race with other sanctioning bodies. Just visit tech when you return to ChampCar to get new upper and lower patch panels for the number panel for free.
