- ESN 1 Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR. Track enforced. There are no exceptions.
- ESN 2 Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

 Track limits will be enforced.
- ESN 3 Flagtronics & Transponders will be available for rent at \$50 per event weekend. Available at Race Central / Registration.
- ESN 4 Passenger seat must be removed for the race.
- ESN 5 Headlights must be white or yellow in color. Brake lights and rear tail lights must be red and clearly seen by the corner workers.

Venue Specific Information

ATTENTION: All vehicles, drivers, and crew must meet the safety and equipment requirements of the <u>2025 BCCR</u>. Stint maximum of 2 hours per driver with a minimum of 1 hour between stints. All fueling is to be completed on pitlane race day. Absolutely no fueling in the garages. Do not store fuel in the garages.

Driver & Crew Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics FT-200 serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:

Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at https://lagtronics.com/champcar

Code35 will be in use at all ChampCar events.

As ChampCar test the timing and scoring capabilities with the Flagtronics FT-200, it is imperitive that your FT200 unit and the GPS is mounted within the rules and that the unit is working.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft. AMP will enforce sound levels. No turn downs, turn aways or baffles over the end of the exhaust meant to cheat sound meters and not reduce sound levels. Anyone caught "lifting" near the sound meters to try and cheat the meters will be immediately asked to leave the Motorsports Park and not allowed to return at AMP's discretion. At two failed attempts the participant is no longer allowed to run for that day. If these terms are not adhered to AMP could receive a fine from the City of Dawsonville for \$1,000. The team will be responsible to pay this fine plus 50% to AMP. No refunds, full or partial, will be entitled to anyone for exceeding sound under no circumstances.

NOTE: Testing, tuning, brake bedding, high speed accelerations or braking will be limited to the track, and not allowed in the paddock or surrounding public roadways. Doing so could result in event expulsion with no fees returned.

2025 Tech Inspection: Please complete your Webbased tech form and the car ready for safety inspection by ChampCar tech staff. Please have your Number / Sponsor panels installed. All teams will be given new 2025 sponsor panels. They must be installed at Tech.

Quiet Time: 5:30pm to 8:45am.

Paddock: Paddock on the asphalt only, do not park vehicles on the grass or "no parking" zones. No vehicle testing, brake bedding, etc. on paddock roads or the skid pad area. Pit bikes, golf carts, side-by-sides must be operated by a licensed driver. Paddock speed limit is 15mph.

Paddock & Pitlane Electric: See "Additional Facilities Charges" or Bring generators.

Weekend Membership Passes: Cannot go over the wall, \$20 for the weekend at registration. Over the wall crew must be full ChampCar club members.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road.

Additional Facilities Charges: Electricity and Camping The following additional services will be charged to the individual user at the AMP front gate. Failure to pay for services will result in fines or ejection from the Facility to the individual user.

Electricity:

- 20 amp electrical plug-in service where available at cold pit: \$15 per day
- 50 amp circuit (5 hook ups @ first come first serve): \$50 per day

Short Term Camping:

- Tent @ \$15/day,
- Trailer @ \$25/day; if 20 amp power is required fee is \$35/day
- RV/Motorhome @ \$35/day (no pro-rated times); if 50 amp power is required fee is \$50/day

Auxiliary vehicles: Anyone operating a non-DOT licensed vehicle on AMP grounds is required to sign a waiver; this is the responsibility of the Licensee to administer upon checkin. AMP is not liable for injury or death of non-DOT licensed vehicle and must be covered by licensee.

Pets: They are welcome in the paddock only, but must be kept on a leash.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road.

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the paddock area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: Open Saturday and Sunday.

Restroom / Showers: Restrooms and showers are available in the paddock garage next to DiscoveryParts.

Fuel on site: None.

Fluid Disposal: Fluid wastes must be placed in approved disposal containers located at various sites in the paddocks and NEVER on the ground.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather. Prepare for rain, heat, and high humidity.

Hotels: The Dawsonville Mountain Moonshine Festival will be happening during this event weekend. Please call hotels in the area early as there are usually other events going on in the area, so hotels may be hard to get.

Event Supplementals Race Car Decals


Per the ChampCar BCCR, the following examples are approved installation locations for the required ChampCar decal package.

Order decal packages with printed numbers at https://rvagfx.com/store Please allow 3-4 weeks before your event as shipping may be slow.

Don't wait until the last minute to order.




Sponsor and number panels must be attached between the arrows as shown. Sponsors may be cut out of the white background but must remain in the same order and be applied in the vertical style as shown. It would be best to plan your graphic style around the number/sponsor panel placement. Per the BCCR, numbers on all number panels shall be black and at minimum 8.0" tall. Fonts shall be a minimum of 1.0" broad (brush stroke) and a maximum of 1.5" wide.



A roof/hood number panel may still be used, but are no longer required. Per the BCCR, numbers on all number panels shall be black and at minimum 8.0" tall. Fonts shall be a minimum of 1.0" broad (brush stroke) and a maximum of 1.5" wide.



TireRack retains exclusive rights to placement at the top of the windshield region. No additional text or logos are permitted within a 6-inch range above or below the TireRack name. While the background is discretionary, it should not be white, orange, or yellow as specified by the BCCR. The TireRack letters must be in white. Vehicles lacking front windshields are required to display a decal at the top of the hood. The TireRack letter size should be 100mm/4" tall, and their orientation can be adjusted to suit the curvature of the windshield.



Class/Number bumper decal must be attached to the car's front and rear as shown between the arrows. For the front decal, pick a place facing forward.



All decals shown on the left image must be applied to your ChampCar before you tech the car and start the race event. Teams may use a ChampCar supplied white die-cut TireRack window decal. Any missing decals can delay the start of your race.

ChampCar Tech will have a limited number of blank number panels for sale along with free sponsor panels, TireRack window die-cut banners, class letter decal, and a blank rear bumper class decal.

The number panel design will allow you to remove the top and lower Sponsor/ChampCar sections if you race with other sanctioning bodies. Just visit tech when you return to ChampCar to get new upper and lower patch panels for the number panel for free.
