Reading the rules is required by all CCES drivers, crew and car builders.

- ESN 1 Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR.
- ESN 2 Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

 Track limits will be enforced.
- ESN 3 Flagtronics will be available for rent at \$50 per event weekend. Available at Race Central / Registration.
- ESN 4 Headlights must be white or yellow in color. Brake lights and rear tail lights must be red and clearly seen by the corner workers.
- ESN 5 Teams/individuals/RVs that plug into power will be charged \$100 per week (Monday-Sunday) for each tap into a receptacle.
- ESN 5 Photo/Media Credentials: Cut-off for event credentials is 2-Weeks before event start. Please visit https://champcar.org/web/media.php

Technical Information

ATTENTION: All vehicles, drivers, and crew must meet the safety and equipment requirements of the 2025 BCCR. Stint maximum of 2 hours per driver with a minimum of 1 hour between stints. All fueling is to be completed on pitlane race day. Absolutely no fueling in the garages. Do not store fuel in the garages.

Driver & Crew Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics FT-200 serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:

Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at https:flagtronics.com/champcar
Code35 will be in use at all ChampCar events. As ChampCar test the timing and scoring capabilities with the Flagtronics FT-200, it is imperitive that your FT200 unit and the GPS is mounted within the rules and that the unit is working.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft.

Venue Specific Information

Alcohol: Absolutely no alcohol may be consumed in the during the day's racing events.

Clothing: Long pants are required on the cold and hot pit lane. No shorts! Closed toed shoes are also required.

Test Day - ChampCar Hosted: The cost is \$150 per car for ChampCar members. All drivers must be full members.

Non-ChampCars are \$250 per car, all waivers must be signed. Includes one membership fee.

All drivers must be ChampCar club members which is \$75. One included with test day entery for non-members.

We will make it easy to join at registration. Sign the forms, and pay the fee.

All test-day participants will visit registration to pay and complete waivers as needed. Cash or credit accepted. All test-day cars must be properly caged, and all safety gear must be worn—NO STREET CARS.

NOTE: Testing, tuning, brake bedding, high speed accelerations or braking will be limited to the track, and not allowed in the paddock or surround public roadways. Doing so could result in event expulsion with no fees returned.

2025 Tech Inspection: Please complete your Webbased tech form and the car ready for safety inspection by ChampCar tech staff. Please have your number panels installed.

They must be installed at Tech.

Garages: There are 65 garages. They cost \$125. Pay when you enter the race. Or, contact registration.

Paddock Electric: Teams/individuals/RVs that plug into power will be charged \$100 per week (Monday-Sunday) for each tap into a receptacle. Pay at the gate to Sebring.

Pitlane Electric: Along pit wall. May be limited.

Pitlane Speed: 20 mph at all times.

Paddock Speeds: Posted or 20 mph at all times.

Radio Frequencies: The ChampCar radio frequencies are reserved for ChampCar official use only and must not be used by the track or teams during the event. Monitor the Race Logs.

Venue Specific Information

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/ paddock area lighting.

Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Clothing: Closed toed shoes are required on pitlane and over the wall. No shorts on the garage side of the stands. Long pants only

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members.
Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you paddock and cold pit lane access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

Pets: They are welcome on property, but must be kept on a leash. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets and must dispose of their waste properly.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road. All minor drivers and crew must complete the ChampCar and Venue minor waivers. See race director for more info.

Camping: Self-contained RV camping is allowed Thursday, Friday & Saturday night. Must be out by 4pm Sunday. Power is \$100 per week. Pay at the gate. You may park your trailers and campers in the Midway parking area after the event.

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. / Yes.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: Concessions will be open 12-8 on

Saturday and 6-10 on Sunday

Fuel on site: Credit Card pumps open

Drones: Unmanned aircraft systems and drones are prohibited at ChampCar Endurance events at all times.

Event Supplementals Race Car Decals


Per the ChampCar BCCR, the following examples are approved installation locations for the required ChampCar decal package.

Order decal packages with printed numbers at https://rvagfx.com/store Please allow 3-4 weeks before your event as shipping may be slow.

Don't wait until the last minute to order.




Sponsor and number panels must be attached between the arrows as shown. Sponsors may be cut out of the white background but must remain in the same order and be applied in the vertical style as shown. It would be best to plan your graphic style around the number/sponsor panel placement. Per the BCCR, numbers on all number panels shall be black and at minimum 8.0" tall. Fonts shall be a minimum of 1.0" broad (brush stroke) and a maximum of 1.5" wide.



A roof/hood number panel may still be used, but are no longer required. Per the BCCR, numbers on all number panels shall be black and at minimum 8.0° tall. Fonts shall be a minimum of 1.0° broad (brush stroke) and a maximum of 1.5° wide.



TireRack retains exclusive rights to placement at the top of the windshield region. No additional text or logos are permitted within a 6-inch range above or below the TireRack name. While the background is discretionary, it should not be white, orange, or yellow as specified by the BCCR. The TireRack letters must be in white. Vehicles lacking front windshields are required to display a decal at the top of the hood. The TireRack letter size should be 100mm/4" tall, and their orientation can be adjusted to suit the curvature of the windshield.



Class/Number bumper decal must be attached to the car's front and rear as shown between the arrows. For the front decal, pick a place facing forward.



All decals shown on the left image must be applied to your ChampCar before you tech the car and start the race event. Teams may use a ChampCar supplied white die-cut TireRack window decal. Any missing decals can delay the start of your race.

ChampCar Tech will have a limited number of blank number panels for sale along with free sponsor panels, TireRack window die-cut banners, class letter decal, and a blank rear bumper class decal.

The number panel design will allow you to remove the top and lower Sponsor/ChampCar sections if you race with other sanctioning bodies. Just visit tech when you return to ChampCar to get new upper and lower patch panels for the number panel for free.

The full road course length is 3.74 miles with 17 turns. Track surface has 2.4 miles of asphalt and 1.2 miles of concrete.



Event Supplementals 2025 Power Fee QGA

Will power fee cover for a weekend or week or single day?

- Duration will be for one week only (starting day will be Monday and ending on Sunday)
- Single day price not available.
- · Each week tag will have its own color.

Which power amps will the power fee apply to?

50- & 30-amp outlets. No longer charging for 110 outlets.

How are we collecting power fees?

Credit Card is preferred method.

What will I receive with each \$100 power purchase?

• Each \$100 power purchase will receive a Tag and zip tie that will go around the end of the power cable that plugs in at the outlet point.

Will I pay for multiple connections at a pedestal?

Yes, each 30 or 50-amp connection that is plugged in count as individual connections.
 Example, (2) Connections will cost \$200, each connecting power end will have its own tag.

Will security people who do the track waivers collect this at time of registration or Gate entries?

• Yes, our gate guard will collect either at Gate location or if registration if staffed by us.

Is Power Fee Mandatory?

No, members can bring their own Generator.
