

## 2022 PITLANE EQUIPMENT CHECK LIST

Please refer to the 2022 BCCR for the latest pit lane requirements. BCCR Section 8 Rules of the pit. Recommended items are NOT required, but can make life easier for you on pit lane during a race.

| 10-Pound Dry-Chemical Fire Extinguisher minimum UL 60 BC or ABC rating  | Required    |
| Extinguisher gauge in the green   | Required    |
| Ten (10) pound bag of grease-sweep, kitty-litter or other absorbent for oil leaks and/or fuel spillage  | Required    |
| Fueling / Gasoline catch pans MUST be metal or sturdy, chemical-resistant plastic, maintain a minimum 3" depth.<br>Large Oil drain pans work great.                                   | Required    |
| All compressed air bottles/gas cylinders, with a pressure in excess of 200 psi, shall have a protective structure around their gauges and valves when in the pit/grid/pre-grid areas. | Required    |
| 5-Gallon Fuel Jugs / Dump Cans - DOT or ChampCar approved. All fueling must be done through a hose attached to the 5-gallon fuel jug.   | Required    |
| Jack and at least one Jack Stand<br>(Jack Stand is required if car is lifted and someone needs to work under the car on pitlane.)   | Recommended |
| Broom and Dustpan - It's recommended, but how are you going to sweep up the kitty litter after your fuel stop?  | Recommended |
| EZ-Up style sun and rain protection   | Recommended |
| Tie-down straps to secure EZ-Up style cover to weights / 5-Gallon buckets filled with sand or water   | Recommended |
| Folding chairs for team   | Recommended |
| Folding table   | Recommended |
| Tools - Socket set, screw drivers, big hammer, hack saw or sawzall, pry bar   | Recommended |
| Lollypop Sign to signal team where your pit box is, or to signal in case radios stop working.   | Recommended |
| Laptop, Tablet, or Smartphone - to monitor http://racehero.io (free) or http://race-monitor.com(paid)   | Recommended |
| Small garden trailer to haul fuel cans to be filled.  | Recommended |
| Zip Ties and Drill with drill bits - to fix loose body panels   | Recommended |
| Spare Bolts and Nuts to replace ones that fall off  | Recommended |
| Impact Wrench / 4-Way - with spare sockets, spare lug nuts or lug bolts. Spare battery for Impact   | Recommended |
| Torque Wrench set for wheel lug torque spec   | Recommended |
| Spare Tires   | Recommended |
| Spare Fuel Fill Cap - in case you lose it   | Recommended |
| 5-Gallon jug of water   | Recommended |
| Spare Engine Oil - Quart cans or pre-fill 500ml "water containers" work best  | Recommended |
| Spare Transmission Oil  | Recommended |
| Spare Differential Oil  | Recommended |
| Spare Brake Fluid   | Recommended |
| Funnels for oils  | Recommended |
| Rags  | Recommended |
| Window Cleaner  | Recommended |
| Paper Towels  | Recommended |
| Small portable air compressor or air can  | Recommended |
| Tarps to cover items from rain and sun  | Recommended |
| Water for drinking  | Recommended |
| Cooler for ice and water  | Recommended |
